MORE THAN JUST A BUILDING

The Men's Mission & Rehabilitation Centre is a 146-bed facility serving men in the community. It functions as an emergency hostel for homeless men age 16 and over and as a residence for men who require longer term care and support.

In addition to providing the traditional accommodation and meals, Men's Mission also offers as part of its program:

- Rehabilitation Counselling
- Men's Clothing Room
- Hostels to Home Pilot Project to assist hard to serve clients to succeed in their own homes.

Additionally, residents of the Men's Mission can access services of support on site from the Community Mental Health Program such as:

- Life Skills Program
- Resource centre with computers and assistance to link with community resources.

Self or agency referrals are accepted.
