FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What time do I arrive for Intake?
 - Your intake time will be set up with you and the intake coordinator. Individuals are usually asked to be at QWH by 9 a.m. on the morning of their intake date. If you are coming from out of town, special arrangements can be made.
2. Do I need a medical form filled out by a physician?
 - A Pre-admission medical form may be required and can be filled out by a doctor or nurse. This will be discussed with you at your interview.
3. Is Quintin Warner House a 12-step program?
 - QWH is not a 12-step program. 12-step attendance is not required but is supported.
4. Am I allowed to contact my family/friends while I am at QWH?
 - For the first 2 weeks at QWH you will be on the Buddy System which means you are not allowed to leave the property unless you are with an approved individual. Phone/email communication is allowed.
5. Am I allowed visitors?
 - Visitors are allowed at the approval and discretion of staff.
6. Will I be allowed to go home for a weekend?
 - After one month in the program, each resident is allowed one weekend away per month. All

weekends away are subject to staff approval.

7. Is QWH staffed 24 hours a day?
 - Yes.
8. Does QWH have a gym facility?
 - QWH does not have a gym facility on site. YMCA membership cards are issued to each resident and gym time is scheduled between 8 am and 10 am from Monday to Friday.
9. Does QWH have a tuition or cost?
 - QWH is funded by the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care and Mission Services of London, therefore you do not have to pay to attend QWH.
 - A \$40 deposit is required to cover any supplies provided to you, this is returned at discharge if all items are returned.
10. Can I start a relationship while I am at QWH?
 - If a person comes into the program single they are expected to stay single and not engage in any sexual/intimate relationships while at QWH.
