Join Mission Services of London for the Coldest Night of the Year as a walker or as a team with your family, friends, or colleagues! Coldest Night of the Year (CNOY) is Mission Services of London's annual fundraising campaign to raise awareness and collect donations for our neighbours in need over the colder months.

Why Walk?

- Raise funds and awareness of Mission Services of London's vital services for men, women, and children in need. Funds raised are directed to the highest-priority needs throughout our sites and programs:
 - Men's Mission: Emergency shelter for men aged 16+
 - **Rotholme Family Shelter**: Emergency shelter for families (single or dual-parent led)
 - Quintin Warner House: Four-month, live-in addiction treatment for men aged 18+
 - Community Mental Health Programs: Includes crisis outreach and intervention, court diversion, transitional case management outreach, and the resource centre
 - Mission Store (797 York Street, at Rectory Street): Operates our Emergency Voucher Program, providing individuals and families with basic-needs items at no cost to them, as well as selling some donated items at a modest price to accommodate all income levels
- Walking in CNOY is a meaningful way to reflect on the challenges faced by people experiencing homelessness in the winter
- Every step helps spark conversations about homelessness, mental health, and substance addiction
- Join others in London who share your commitment to supporting our neighbours in need

Last Year's Walk (2024):








