Canada-wide walk helps vulnerable populations locally

London, ON – On Saturday, Feb. 24th more than 20,000 Canadians – of all ages, in six time zones, in cities and towns from the Pacific to the Atlantic - will walk together in the "Coldest Night of the Year". Although temperatures in London are expected to be well above average, no night is colder than when faced alone.

Locally, Mission Services of London is organizing the event for the seventh time; it expects 300 walkers and more than 60 volunteers. With a fundraising goal of \$65,000 this year, proceeds will be spread across the five Mission Services branches to help support men, women and children experiencing homelessness in London.
