CONTEST RULES

1. Contestants will create a meal plan for 10 people. The meal plan should include an appetizer, a main dish and dessert.
2. In past years, the Scan Away Hunger™ version of the kick-off contest has been run in person at a participating campaign location. This year, in order to ensure that all participants have access to the same ingredient pricing and no one contestant has an advantage, every contest entry must assume that ingredients are to be purchased via Walmart Canada's online grocery website.
 - a. **Your meal plan may not exceed a budget of \$31.11. (subtotal, not including tax) Why? \$3.11 is the cost of one meal for a neighbour in need at Mission Services of London.**

In order to submit the budget piece for your entry, please visit Walmart's online website <https://www.walmart.ca/en/grocery/N-117> and build a Cart as though you were going to purchase your entire ingredient list. You do not need to sign up for an account; simply start shopping and add the items to your cart.
 - b. **Bonus points will be given for matching the \$31.11 total!**
 - c. **For contest entry, please print your cart as a PDF.** Here are instructions on how to do that:
 - i. Click on the cart icon in the top right
 - ii. Right click your mouse on the white space to the left of your list
 - iii. Select "print"
 - iv. Change the destination drop down to read "save as PDF"
 - v. Click save
 - vi. Save to your desktop
 - d. Attach the PDF of your cart ingredients to your composed email
3. Contestants are to submit their entries by email to Elaine Keller at ekeller@missionservices.ca **by Thursday, October 28th**. In your email please indicate what you will be making with your ingredients. Representatives from each of the Mission Services of London kitchens (Men's Mission, Quintin Warner House and Rotholme Family Shelter) will act as judges and pick the top contest entry – one per each branch.
4. The winning **main dish** for each branch will be prepared and served as a meal for Mission Services of London clients sometime in the month of November. Just the main dish, not the appetizer or dessert. Representatives cannot pick the same winner. If there is a tie, a representative from each of the tying branches will play rock, paper, scissors to break the tie (the winner of rock, paper, scissors will keep the selected entry and the other branch will select the second highest scoring entry available from its ranking).
5. The winner for each branch will receive a \$50 restaurant gift card, and a physically distant photo op on the lawn of the branch that the contestant's main dish was served at.
6. Judges will use a score sheet during judging of contest entries to ensure the contestants have followed all the rules. A total of 1,000 points may be awarded.
7. The winning contestants will be notified a Mission Services of London representative via phone or email.
